SOP – GCCC Trophies

Qualifying Criteria

Greenhorn Trophy

- Awarded to the boat attending the most club rallies.
- One point awarded for each rally attended.
- Must be a club boat with a club member as skipper.
- Only programmed rallies count, alternative venues allowed only if there is an official change of venue notified by the leader for the rally.
- In the event of a tie on points, the boat with the shortest waterline length wins.

Stowaway Trophy

To encourage people into sailing and build experience for those without boats.

- Awarded to the person who attends the most rallies on a club boat as a stowaway, but who has not previously been awarded the Trophy.
- One point awarded to each member staying overnight on a club boat at the rally.
- In the event of a points tie, the stowaway experiencing the most different boats wins.
- Skippers and regular crew can be stowaways on another club boat.

Welcome Aboard Trophy

To encourage club members to take stowaways on club rallies.

- Awarded to the boat that attends the most rallies with a stowaway onboard.
- One point awarded per rally to the boat taking at least one stowaway.
- In the event of a tie on points, the boat with the shortest waterline length wins.

Note: It is unlikely that a person could win the Greenhorn and Stowaway trophy in the same season. However, somebody could conceivably win both the Greenhorn and the Welcome Aboard Trophies.

Other Trophies

- Tom Edwards - outstanding feat of seamanship
- Bader Rose Bowl - outstanding contribution by a member
